#### The Lawrence "Uncle Bo" Campos Scholarship Fund:

The Scholarship is open to Hawaii Island graduating seniors with a 2.5 GPA or higher, who demonstrated academic achievement, and community participation, and has paddled at the club or high school level in the past three years. In addition to strong academics, the candidate's merit of active volunteerism and leadership in the school, community, church, and/or employment will be considered.

#### Please do the following tasks and forward to Kai 'Ōpua Canoe Club by Friday, May 23, 2025:

1) Provide your most recent transcript and SAT and/or ACT scores if available.

2) Include a one page, personal statement (AI generated writing not accepted) reflecting your academic program, future goals, career interests, background experiences, community activities, leadership skills, service to others, employment or other relevant details.

3) Use the provided Recommendation Letter form and gather at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, clergy or community supporter. Provide the other letter from your paddling coach who worked with you in the last three years.

4) Letter of acceptance from a furthuring education institution (university, college, trade school).

Put them together in one packet and forward to Scholarship Committee, Kai 'Ōpua Canoe Club, PO Box 3079, Kailua-Kona Hawaii 96745. If you have questions, email scholarship@kaiopua.org. The Scholarship Committee will review all applicant materials and recommend the candidate who best meets the intent of the scholarship award to the Kai 'Ōpua Canoe Club Board of Directors.
